Forms 3, 5, 6 in Malaita, Isabel, Makira, Temotu, Renbel, and Central have been recalled to start back classes on 27th April 2020. Education Authorities and School leaders are expected to ensure respective schools begin classes as advised by MEHRD. 2. Form 3, 5 6 in non-high risk zones in Western, Choiseul and Guadalcanal are also expected to start school. Your call to resume classes was on 27th April 2020. 3. ECE, Primary, Forms 1, 2 and 4 in Malaita, Isabel, Makira, Temotu, Rennell/Bellona and Central, classes was recalled to start on 4th May 2020. Education Authorities and School leaders are expected to ensure schools commence as advised by MEHRD. 4. Guadalcanal Schools from Aruligo Westwards and Schools from GPPOL East Wards – recall of classes is this week. Instructions conveyed to you was for classes to start on 11th May 2020. 5.
