Finalized School/Class Enrolment Lists for Forms 3, 5 & 6</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Finalized School enrolments must be sent to NEAD, the latest 30th June 2020. b. Data collected from enrolment lists is vital for tender processes prior to printing of final examination scripts and distributions c. No or Late Submissions will result in “No examination Scripts sent to your school” hence, students will not be placed to any school or have any qualification transcripts/certificates. <p>2. Subject Stocktaking</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Respective subject Teachers must indicate topics already covered during the first eight weeks of schooling (before the State of Emergency) 	
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	b) Teachers are encouraged to follow the correct sequence of teaching from the Solomon Islands National curriculum books and materials.

Form 4s and Form 5s School Based Assessments (SBAs) and National Form 6s Internal Assessments (IAs)	<p>To all Subject teachers teaching Forms 4, 5 and 6 with SBA and IA requirement,</p> <p>You are informed that all School Based Assessments and Internal Assessments (IAs) still stand and you are still required to complete these SBA and IA requirement and submit all students marks and samples of projects accordingly to NEAD.</p> <p>The only change will be the due dates, which NEAD is giving you soon next week. Means, the due dates for most of these SBAs and IAs will be further extended BUT it is a requirement that you must do all and submit all to NEAD accordingly.</p>	ALL SBAs and IAs still stand but only the due dates will be extended and remember to align your tasks with the revised school calendar 2020.
